GP Palliative Aged Care Small Grant

COORDINARE - South Eastern NSW Primary Health Network (PHN) is excited to introduce our GP Palliative Aged Care small grant program for GPs that provide clinical support to Residential Aged Care Homes.

The program provides general practitioners (GPs) an opportunity to update their skills and knowledge and that of the broader aged care workforce, ultimately improving the communication processes between the GP and RACH staff and the quality of palliative care provided to residents.

Palliative care scholarship

- COORDINARE's GP grants support GPs in gaining experience and skills in defined clinical disciplines.
- The program provides remuneration of \$3000 per participant payable on completion of grant requirements.
- The program is for a total of up to 20 hours over a six month period, which consists of 6 monthly 2 hour workshop sessions, and individual 2 hour monthly mentoring and discussion with course facilitator (mode TBD).
- The program will provide peer networking opportunities that aim to build supportive relationships between general practice and the residential aged care workforce.
- This program will contain CPD hours that can be self-reported; 12 hours EA (Educational Activities), 10 hours RP (Reviewing Performance). 4 hours MO (Measuring Outcomes).
- GPs will be required to complete pre and post evaluations and course activities outlined in the program workbook.



Expression of interest process

All applications received will be reviewed by the GP Scholarship Advisory Committee including representatives from both COORDINARE and Illawarra Shoalhaven LHD. This is a competitive process due to limited places.
