## Illawarra Shoalhaven GP Scholarship: Palliative Care

COORDINARE - South Eastern NSW Primary Health Network (PHN) is excited to introduce our GP Scholarship Program offering short term paid placements within clinical areas of the Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District.

These placements provide General Practitioners (GPs) an opportunity to update their knowledge, skills and networks by working in a supportive environment with local non-GP specialists and clinical teams.



- COORDINARE's GP Scholarships support GPs in gaining experience and skills in defined clinical disciplines.
- Each Scholarship provides remuneration of \$150 per hour payable on completion of scholarship requirements.
- Placements are for a total of 40 hours. There is some flexibility e.g. 4 hours a week over 10 weeks; 8 hours a week over 5 weeks or 40 hours in a 1 week block.
- GPs will observe and participate in patient care within the hospital and community settings including but not limited to ward rounds, clinics, and outpatient services and will include conducting of patient assessments and appropriate referrals.
- The Scholarships will provide networking opportunities that aim to build supportive relationships between general practice and tertiary care providers, and will enhance skill sets within the community.
- This Scholarship will be accredited for 40 RACGP CPD hours, 5 EA (Educational activities) and 35 RP (Reviewing performance).
- GPs will be required to complete pre and post evaluations and course activities outlined in the scholarship workbook.
- Successful applicants will be required to meet requirements for ISLHD recruitment activation as an Honorary Medical Officer.



## **Expression of interest process**

All applications received will be reviewed by the GP Scholarship Advisory Committee including representatives from both COORDINARE and Illawarra Shoalhaven LHD. This is a competitive process due to limited places.
