

How to Register for the Recognise & Respond Online Course


To access the training, please follow the steps below:

1. **Go to:** <https://mentalhealth.learning.blackdoginstitute.org.au/learn>
2. **Click on** the 'Register' link.
3. **Complete the registration form** by entering the following details:
 - Your **email address**
 - Your **first name** and **last name**
 - **Create a password** of your choice
 - **Enter the access code:**
