COVID-19 cases and clusters in NSW	Please find the weekly epidemiological reports attached. This week has seen no locally acquired cases in the Illawarra Shoalhaven area, but an increase in locally acquired cases in NSW. 1 new case in ISLHD is a returned traveller in hotel quarantine.
	89% of current cases in NSW are linked to known clusters. The largest current cluster is linked to City Tattersalls gym in Pitt St, Sydney. There is also currently a significant cluster associated with Liverpool hospital ED and new emerging cases linked to Concord Hospital ED , which has restricted visitors this week whilst investigation and
	contact tracing is proceeding.

Clinical characteristics of	This is a prospective cohort study of children admitted to hospitals in the UK with
children and young people	COVID-19 infection. The study confirms that COVID-19 in children and young people is
admitted to hospital with	generally less severe than in adults and mortality is rare. Three symptom clusters
COVID-19	were found: most commonly a respiratory cluster (fever, cough, shortness of breath,
	runny nose); a mucocutaneous cluster (fever, headache, myalgia, sore throat, nausea,
	abdominal pain, diarrhoea, fatigue, rash, conjunctivitis); and rarely a neurological
	cluster characterised by seizures and confusion. The second cluster of symptoms has
	been identified in other international studies and classified as a multisystem
	inflammatory syndrome in children and adolescents temporally associated with SARS-
	CoV-2 (MIS-C). This study helps to refine the clinical characteristics and epidemiology of this syndrome.
