


MODEL OF CARE Nurse-led diabetes clinic

MODEL OF CARE Nurse-led diabetes clinic

LEAD GP & PRACTICE NURSE

- 1. Identify target population using search features of your electronic medical records program.
- 2. Refine patient list to identify patients eg.HbA1C>7% or no HbA1C measurement within 6 months.
- 3. Prepare format for nurse led health review appointment and template to be used for each review appointment.
- 4. Prepare patient invitations, consent and survey.

ADMIN TEAM

- 5. Mail out invitations.
- 6. If they don't get a response, phone calls made to patients 2 weeks after mail out
- 7. If they do get a response and:
 - a. Don't want to participate make patient aware they can choose to book an appointment at another time when ready to participate.
 - b. Do want to participate book appointment for nurse led review.

PRACTICE NURSE & PATIENT

8. Nurse led health review appointment 40 mins

REGULAR GP & PRACTICE NURSE

- 9. Discuss patient with regular GP.
- 10. Plan for investigations as appropriate.
 - a. If investigations are required:
 - i. Provide referrals eg. pathology forms and instruct patient to attend for blood work etc
 - ii. Attend for GP referred investigations/tests
 - iii. Go to point 12
 - b. If investigations are not required go to point 12.

ADMIN TEAM

11. Book appointment with regular GP for follow up consult within 1 week.

REGULAR GP & PATIENT

- 12. GP diabetes appointment:
 - Medical management of diabetes, address care plan provision/review.
 - Encourage educational follow up with practice nurse 3-6months.
 - Schedule follow up HbA1C.
